# SPECIAL ROAD INSPECTION MEETING

All Supervisors present, also Curtis Christopherson, patrol operator.

Left Pine Center about 9 A.M., covering the west part first, then north of Hwy. 2 on west Town Line. East to Hwy. 8, north to Camp Lake on Town Line road. About 1/2 mile east of Hwy. 8 a 4-foot extension on the 24" culvert was approved. Another culvert should be added about 1/4 mile east of this. A 4-foot extension on the 30" culvert should be added, this being about 1/4 mile east of the last one. Just before the S-curves begin, widen and put in ditches on both sides of the road.

South 1 mile on Hwy. 8 to Camp Lake road (west), east to the lake. About 1/4 mile from the corner where we turned south, a 20" culvert should be put in. There is none there now. Then followed road on north shore of lake, found a culvert that has to be cleaned out.

South of Pine Center on Hwy. 8 (1 mile) to gravel road. Two places, near each other, need 4 or 5 loads of gravel each. On the south end of Lake Erskine the road should be straightened and some stumps removed, for turn-around. The road to the northeast side of Rock Lake is too narrow to be maintained by snowplow or road patrol.

The road into Platte Lake needs widening. Some trees to be removed, brushed on both sides, and guy wire to power pole must be moved. This is at the narrow neck, just before the turn-around "loop." At south road to Platte Lake there is a low spot that needs a culvert, just before Davis's place.

Went east of Hwy. 8 to Barstow's, east again to dead end.

Came back to Pine Center, then east to the Camp Lake road to the end. Came back along this west road to Hwy. 2, then went to the east Camp Lake road to Wallace's place. Next, turned south at Evans's corner, then took west road to dead end. Went east to Whitefish Lake, then south to end of road at Schmolke's. Backed up all the way to Van Keuren's. Took Hwy. 2 east to Whitefish Lake road. Found a culvert to be cleaned out, and one or more loads of gravel to go on Deutsch's road. Continued west to dead end at Eckerman's. Some places here the curves should be straightened out on this road. Along the lake some wagon wheels interfere with the road and should be moved out of the way.

Returned to Pine Center at Schellin's where one (1) Road bill was paid to Ed. Pelarski Sr. for pushing snow off road and dump with large loader. Check #33 for \$76.00.
