Minutes of the Proceedings of the Annual Town Meeting

The Annual Town Meeting, held in the Town of Roosevelt in the County of Crow Wing and State of Minnesota, at Pine Center Sportsmans Hall on the 8 day of March, 1966, was called to order by Leon Schellin

and ERWIN Klose was then chosen to preside as Moderator at the meeting.

The Moderator, at the opening of the meeting, stated the business to be transacted and the order of same, as follows: To elect one Supervisor for the term of three years, to fill the place of ERWIN Klose whose term expires; one Town Clerk, one Treasurer, one Assessor, Justice of the Peace, Constable, one Town School Superintendent

Also to determine by ballot ONE DISTRICT SUPERVISOR FOR SOIL CONSERVATION FOR A TERM OF 5 YEARS
