Minutes for February 1, 2005 meeting read by Clerk. Motion to approve by Al Bosn, seconded by Dan Wells, motion carried.

Planning & Zoning – 2004 Annual Planning & Zoning Report & Monthly Reports received by Clerk. Clerk informed Board that the variance was approved for Robert & Judy Jensen & the rezoning approved for Louis Buie, Jr.

Open Forum – Margaret Helman & family notified Board that they are considering building a restraunt/café (seat approx 30-50 people) on the property on Co Rd 8 between North & South Platte Lake Road. They had talked to Planning & Zoning, were informed to inform Board of their plans & to get a letter of approval from Roosevelt Township. Clerk will prepare letter & get to Helman's by end of this month.

Recycling – nothing to discuss, but did mention that we need to allocate additional funds to recycling at Annual Meeting. SCORE funds are not adequate to cover costs and personnel expenses.

Road & Equipment – Discussed the article that appeared in the Mille Lacs Messenger by Viv Clark. Clerk will contact attorney to discuss possible lawsuit, Board will discuss at next months meeting when Don returns & we get info from attorney.

Al stated that we need to get a new agreement with Garrison Township, he reviewed the State of MN Best Practice Review & they discussed agreements between townships.

Board & Clerk received a letter from the Tracy's about their current driveway into their property. This is tabled till next month's meeting, Clerk to contact attorney.

Still no word from the surveyor (Westwood Professionals), Clerk will call to check on status. Jim Tracy commented that Westwood had been out to Camp Lake Road & done other surveys, so what's the hold-up with ours.

Dan Wells made motion to approve Claims, seconded by Al Bosn, motion carried.

Annual Meeting preparation – Budget discussion included the increase of gasoline costs & gravel costs this past year. Also need to put monies into Recycling to cover costs. An additional expense this next year would be a new roof for the garage. Also if decision to go ahead with the lawsuit against Garrison Township we'd need monies for that. Propose a 10% increase for Budget over 2004 at the Annual Meeting.

Clerk received notice the Office of County Assessor that they have scheduled the Local Board of Appeal and Equalization for Roosevelt Township has been scheduled for the 18th day of May 2005 at 2:00 PM at Roosevelt Town Hall. Board is okay with this date.

Crow Wing County had scheduled training sessions for Local Board of Appeal and Equalization for February 25, 2005. The training was cancelled and will be rescheduled sometime after June & will contact us when dates are set. At least one supervisor must be trained before 1/1/2006 for the meeting to be held at our Township. If no supervisors trained the meetings will need to be held at the County.
