Eric explained that the reason for this meeting was to look at & discuss the road projects the Board had identified as priority for this year.

Handouts: Road/Bridge Fund Analysis & KLD Road Construction Estimates

-Camp Lake Road (East Location) Estimated Cost of \$29,033
Alignment correction for 30 mph design curve with safe sight distance & positive drainage. 24 foot driving surface, 4 foot ditches 2 feet deep with 4:1 inslopes, 3:1 back slopes.

-Camp Lake Road (West Location) Estimated Cost of \$4,659 Approximately 300 feet of ditching & installation of centerline culvert to fix current drainage issue of a residential driveway.

-North Platte Lake Road Estimated Cost of \$30,664 20 foot road surface, 4 foot ditch 1.5 feet deep with 3:1 inslopes & 2:1 back slopes (ditching only on the north side of road).

Board decided that North Platte Lake Road would be the project for this year. First thing would be to discuss the plans with the residents associated with this project & get their approval before proceeding. Clerk to get names, addresses & phone numbers of residents to Eric. Bob Miller will supply picture/map for Eric to assist with discussion Need to have all the residents' approval before proceeding.

Discussion with resident on Camp Lake Road. Resident not receptive to the new alignment going north based on assumption by resident that this might be part of his future building site.

Eric suggested that Jerry could work on Camp Lake Road (West). Both Dan & Bill felt that this work should wait until we do the work on Camp Lake Road (East) and do these both together.

Bob Miller informed Board that we're on the list with County for White Pine Road grant monies. We need to talk with residents regarding road ROW in case monies available this year. Bob will get info to Dan regarding existing & proposed lines so Dan can talk to residents.
